ACTIONS TO REDUCE WASTE

- Sorting and recycling of waste from set-up, during the show and right through to breakdown
- Putting in place waste sorting points at aisle crossings: we can all make a difference!
- Integration of recyclable or re-usable materials into stand design
- Re-use of show furniture after the event
- Repurposing of recyclable carpet by clients in industrial plastics, especially the car industry
- Use of recyclable and/or recycled materials for interior signage
- All the show's communication tools use recycled materials and paper or are online
- Collection of cigarette butts and masks by "EcoMégot" for recycling as information panels



ACTIONS FOR LOW-CARBON ENERGY AND TRANSPORT

- Purchase and use of green electricity throughout the event
- Reduction of energy consumption, in particular by using LED lighting and heating controls
- Offering exhibitors shared mobility options, provided by the show's official service providers
- Incentives to use low-carbon transport:
 - Publication on the Pollutec.com "Useful information" webpage of a GHG calculator for optimising travel
 - In partnership with the City of Lyon, the sale of tickets for public transport to the airport and train stations
 - Promoting the certified carbon-neutral "Eurecab" VFH solution, along with car-sharing



ACTIONS FOR ECO-RESPONSIBLE CATERING

- On-site caterers no longer use plastics but containers, tableware and packaging made from renewable and ecocompostable materials
- The emphasis will be on organic, local and seasonal products
- Unsold goods will be collected by the "Le Chaînon manquant" organisation to combat food waste
- Recycling of organic kitchen waste
- Recovery and treatment of edible oils by Bioval'uiles










Private sector


Distribution of private sector visitors by company size











Some figures on forum participations

- The Water and Waste forums bring together the most local authorities and administrations:
 - 18% on Waste
 - 15% on Water
- The Waste and Sustainable Cities and Territories forums bring together the most public sector + local authorities/administration
 - 25% on Waste
 - 24% on Sustainable Cities and Territories
 - The Waste is the most international with 92 participants from outside metropolitan France and 31 countries represented (including overseas)
- The Sustainable Industry and Energy forums are the most attractive for the industry sector:
 - 24% on Sustainable Industry
 - 17% on Energy
