The 2023 edition of the show will be designed around the central theme of "decompartmentalisation" to improve the way we understand and address the major environmental challenges of today and tomorrow.

Once again, the event will cover a wide range of topics – from reindustrialisation, agriculture and the urgency of adaptation to investment in public infrastructure, to name just a few.

Pollutec is exclusively announcing the first guest speakers in the show's conference space. They will cover a wide range of cross-cutting themes reflecting the four pillars of this year's edition: Resources, Adaptation, Engagement and Employment.

Jean-Louis Etienne, Expedition leader, Polar POD, will be on the Tribune stage on Wednesday 11 October (11.00-11.30) to present the Polar POD and the implications of its findings (*Engagement* pillar).

A doctor by training and a renowned explorer, Jean-Louis Etienne was the first man to reach the North Pole solo in 1986 and completed the first full crossing of Antarctica in 1989-90. He is a committed environmentalist and his many education-oriented scientific expeditions aim to raise awareness about the Polar regions and to learn more about their impact on the Earth's climate and life forms. In 2025, he will embark on a pioneering exploration of the Southern Ocean, on board the oceanographic station Polar POD. He has also written around 30 books.

Émilie Alberola, Director, EcoAct South Europe (an Eviden company), will be speaking at the session on "Decarbonising and reindustrialising France – the same agenda" (Adaptation pillar) on Tuesday 10 October (11.45-12.30).

Émilie Alberola has a PhD in Economics and is an **expert on climate policy** and a **member of the Economic Council for Sustainable Development at the French Ministry of Ecological Transition**. With over 15 years' experience, Émilie is a **respected expert on climate finance and carbon pricing**. Before being appointed Director of EcoAct South Europe, she was Director for R&I and Head of Climate Policy and Market Mechanisms at EcoAct.

Féris Barkat, Founder, Banlieues Climat, will speak about young people and their environmental commitment (*Engagement* pillar; *Employment* pillar) on Thursday 12 October (10.15-11.45).

At the age of 21, Féris Barkat was studying Politics and Philosophy at the London School of Economics. He decided to abandon his studies to **educate his generation about climate issues**, mainly on Tiktok, on the radio and in working-class neighbourhoods. As a cofounder of *Banlieues Climat*, he aims to **promote "eco-emancipation" in working-class neighbourhoods**. He also gives talks as a winner of the award À voix Haute pour la Biodiversité ("Speaking up for Biodiversity") and, as part of the Youth CNR (National Council for Reform), he has made **recommendations to the Prime Minister** on climate adaptation and education. He has recently been nominated as one of the 30 under 30 environmentalists to follow by Usbek & Rica/NOWU.

Caroline Mini, Sustainability Manager, Verkor, will be speaking at the session on "Strategic metals – how can we balance increasing demand with limited resources?" (Resources pillar; Employment pillar) on Wednesday 11 October (11.45-12.30).

Caroline Mini is a **civil engineer with a PhD from the University of California**, Los Angeles, and a former consultant for Accenture. Since September 2022, she has been the **Sustainability Manager** for Verkor.

Founded in July 2020, Verkor is fast-tracking the **production of low-carbon batteries in France and in Europe**, to respond to the continent's growing demand for electric vehicles, e-mobility and stationary storage. Verkor will open its fully digital 4.0 pilot line in 2023, as part of the Gigafactory project due in 2025.

Jean-Luc Fugit, Member of Parliament for the 11th constituency of the Rhône and President of the French Energy Council, will speak about water resource management and usage, where it is essential to break out of silos (Resources pillar) on Tuesday 10 October (15.00-16.00).

Jean-Luc Fugit has a PhD in chemistry and works as a lecturer and researcher focusing on environment, energy and air pollution. He was elected Member of Parliament for the 11th constituency of the Rhône in June 2017, at the age of 47, and was re-elected in June 2022. He is President of the French Energy Council, Vice-president of the Parliamentary Office for the Evaluation of Scientific and Technological Choices, and a member of the Sustainable Development, Spatial and Regional Planning Committee of the French National Assembly.

Emeline Baume, Vice-President of Lyon Métropole with responsibility for the Economy, Employment, Trade, Digital Technologies and Public Procurement will speak at the session on "The textile industry: societal changes and environmental impact" on Wednesday 11 October (16.45-17.45).

Emeline Baume has been a green politician since 2008. Initially responsible for Green Spaces and the Social Economy in Lyon's 1st arrondissement, she then became metropolitan councillor for Circular Economy and Waste Prevention and led the city's "Zero-waste territory" initiative. She is President of the National Circular Economy Council. Since July 2020, she has been Vice-President of Lyon Métropole with responsibility for the Economy, Employment, Trade, Digital Technologies and Public Procurement.

Matthieu Guesné, CEO and co-founder of Lhyfe, will be discussing how hydrogen could support a transition to regional, low-carbon energy (Resources pillar; Employment pillar) on Wednesday 11 October (16.15-17.15).

Matthieu Guesné is an electronics and IT engineer. He is a specialist in batteries and electricity storage.

Co-founded in 2017 by Matthieu Guesné and Nolwenn Belléguic, Lhyfe is a European group dedicated to the energy transition, as a producer and supplier of green and renewable hydrogen.

Its production sites aim to provide access to green and renewable hydrogen in **industrial quantities**, and to move to a clean energy model allowing **entire sections of industry and mobility to decarbonise**.
